

# Sunshine Coasting

Perhaps anticipating the last fine weekend of the summer, over 30 BMOC members turned out at Horsehoe Bay for the 9:20 ferry to Langdale on Sunday, Sept. 26.

In all there were 52 bikes on the ferry, most of which eventually found their way to the Back Eddy Pub in Egmont for lunch.

The Sunshine Coast Ride is billed as a casual ride, a sort of do it yourself event. You ride at your own speed, in a group or single. You really can't get lost, Highway 101 is the only route, point A to B, sure there are a couple of worthwhile detours, Red Roofs Road for one. Follow 101 north and it takes you to the Earl's Cove ferry terminal, a right turn then takes you to Egmont on the Skookumchuk Narrows. Lots of places to stop along the way, Gibsons and Gibsons Landing, Roberts Creek, Davis Bay, Sechelt, Sargeants Bay, Secret Cove, Madeira Park, Garden Bay, Ruby Lake.

Destination Highways rates 101 as #23, but the twisties between Madiera Park and Egmont alone are worth the ride.
